

top five budget tips: *wedding videography*



1. Found your dream videographer but your budget is X amount of dollars? Speak up! Ask if they offer packages or deals in your price range. The worst they tell you is no.

4. Some wedding videographers have assistants. If you can't quite afford them for the entire wedding then ask about getting the assistant for only part of the time.

5. Ask about the possibility of purchasing the edited ceremony but only an unedited cut of the reception. This could save you money in time and labor costs.

2. Some videographers are flexible and offer discounts during slow seasons or due to a cancellation.

3. Lose the extras. Ditch the extensive pre-wedding film, nix the extra reception hours, or request only the ceremony.
